- 9.1 Replace "A Division" with "Big Boats (Including Multis & A Division)" Remove "B Division 1st Line, 1st, 2nd, 3rd PHRF 1st, 2nd, PHS, Pacific Keelboat Challenge 1st, 2nd, 3rd Line, Young 88 1st, 2nd, 3rd Line 1st, 2nd PHS, Open Multihull Division 1st Line 1st, 2nd, 3rd PHS".

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Race will be governed by the Rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- ~~1.2 On the water judging may be used for this event. World Sailing Appendix Q as amended may apply. Judges will fly code flag 'J'.~~
- 1.3 Appendix T will apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI) that will be posted on the regatta website www.aucklandregatta.co.nz on Monday 22nd March 2021.

3 ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 This is an open event, for members of any yacht club, the series is open to all keel boats and multihulls that meet the requirements below;

The handicap splits are for guidance only. The OA will have final say on what division each boat will sail in. Divisions will be confirmed in January 2021, a minimum of 6 boats must be entered into a division at this time or the OA may merge the divisions.

- 3.3 The Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) Safety Regulations Part II Category 5 shall apply for keel boats and multihulls.
- 3.4 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part V Category B shall apply for trailer yachts.
- 3.5 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part VII shall apply for sport multihulls.
- 3.6 Rule 52 'Manual Power' shall not apply.
- 3.7 Rule 51 is modified to allow boats with moveable/variable ballast systems and/or canting keels to compete. Boats shall comply with World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Appendix K and YNZ Safety Regulations 6.1(K) and 6.2(K).
- 3.8 Sails carried for any one day shall remain on board for all races that day. The sails carried on any one day need not be the same sails as those carried on the other days of the regatta.
- 3.9 Crew on board for any one day shall remain on board for all races that day unless the Race Officer for the relevant course agrees otherwise because of injury or suchlike. Crew on board on any one day need not be the same crew on the other days of the regatta.

4 ENTRY AND FEES

- 4.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form online at aucklandregatta.co.nz, a non-refundable entry fee shall be paid prior to racing;

- 4.2 Yachts wishing to sail under PHRF handicap must ensure that they have selected this on their entry and supplied their current PHRF registration number.

6 RACING AREA & COURSES

The races will be held within the Waitemata Harbour and Hauraki Gulf. The courses to be sailed will be both windward leeward (W/L) and harbour course(s) as described below

A Division	4 windward leeward and 2 Harbour courses
40R Division	12 windward leeward courses
B Division	4 windward leeward and 2 Harbour courses
C Division (inc. Young 88, MRX & Pied Piper)	4 windward leeward and 2 Harbour courses
Young 88	4 windward leeward and 2 Harbour courses
Pied Piper	4 windward leeward and 2 Harbour courses
Passage Divisions	2 Harbour 2 Passage courses
Big Boats (including Multihull & A Div)	2 Passage courses
Pacific Keelboat Challenge	12 windward leeward courses
Open Multihulls	4 windward leeward and 2 Harbour courses
Sports Boats Championship	8 windward leeward courses

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The races shall be scored as per RRS Appendix A using the Low Point system.
- 7.2 For the Pacific Keelboat Challenge and 40R divisions twelve (12) races are scheduled.
- 7.3 For the passage race division's two (2) races are scheduled.
- 7.4 For the sports boat division eight (8) races are scheduled.
- 7.5 For all other divisions six (6) races are scheduled.
- 7.6 Yachts will exclude their one (1) worst score after six (6) races, and exclude their two worst (2) scores after ten (10) races.

8 ADVERTISING

- 8.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority (OA).
- 8.2 Any advertising material (other than that supplied by the OA) displayed on competing boats shall be declared on the entry form and approved in writing by the OA.
